LEARNING ENGLISH TO FACE INTERNATIONAL CHALLENGES

International French Baccalauréat

The International French Baccalauréat (BFI) is a diploma recognised by many countries worldwide. This option is offered in international school and gets students ready to study at university.

All the courses in this programme encourage openness to the world and language skills, but also intellectual curiosity and critical thinking. All these skills are key skills for a successful future.

As we are aware of this challenge, we will open by 2024, a Year 11 class ('seconde') with bilingual courses and certifications in 3 foreign languages to prepare our students for the French International Baccalauréat.

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Thanks to our bilingual or native teachers, each student benefits from 10 hours of lessons in English every week.”



Because of its importance in socio-economic exchanges, speaking English fluently is now essential. Therefore, having an English certification is now part of every student's career path, regardless of their course of study or project.

We base our lessons on speaking activities and real-life situations.

Thanks to our partnership with **Cambridge English** and their effectiveness, our teaching team has different tools and motivations:

- A certified, motivating and rewarding progression. From A1 to C1 level, our students' progress is validated by certifications recognised by more than 25,000 universities, companies and government organisations around the world.
- **Cambridge English qualifications are one of the keys to our students' success:** they are an asset for the preparation of their Parcoursup application, for admission to all selective courses and courses in short supply, and they are accepted as proof of English

language level by international universities.

- An approach based on speaking activities and real-life situations. In class, our teachers do their best to encourage students to express themselves and to arouse their interest, based on subjects they can relate to and engaging resources. Grammar and writing are also approached in a lively manner.

School A also offers certifications in:

- German (KMK : Kulturministerkonferenz),
- Spanish (DELE: Diploma de Español como Lengua Extranjera).

ÉCOLE A: ACTIVE AND INDIVIDUALISED LEARNING

Our students need to acquire the fundamental academic knowledge as much as they need to develop the cross-curricular skills they will need tomorrow.

Which is why :

- **Each course is organised in small groups**, with teachers trained to keep each student engaged, using a different, active, and individualised approach.
- **Our pedagogy, encouraging action and collaboration between peers**, is based on the values of cooperation. By participating in projects and debates, students learn more over time and develop their ability to understand and memorise.
- **We encourage the development of practical and cross-curricular skills** such as critical thinking, speaking, leadership, commitment, creativity, and innovation.
- **At École A, teaching also takes place «outside the classroom»**. To learn in a different way and to give meaning to learning, one must know how to get out of the classroom and see the world, cultural outings or activities in the field are the norm instead of being the exception in the daily life of our students.
- **Learning English and being open to the Anglo-Saxon culture are fundamental**. Our English courses, led by bilingual teachers, are based on an oral and active approach which encourages the participation of students and their progress.

SMALL GROUPS

Learning faster to go further.

All our courses are taught in a class of up to 15 students, or in workshops of 6 to 10 students, to encourage and strengthen pair work. These formats enhance the acquisition of knowledge and national education programmes, but also increase the capacity of students to acquire new skills throughout their course.

- **A lively and committed educational community** where students cultivate continuous learning and develop their personality and skills.
- **A joint project** where students and parents can participate fully.

- **Economic and entrepreneurial culture** (legal knowledge, design thinking, economics, management, digital knowledge).

THE PROS OF ÉCOLE A

Individualised support :

Each student receives advice from a member of the educational team, whether it is from an educational adviser or a tutor. They also have a single point of contact who follows their studies throughout the year.

Guidance and future :

From the end of junior secondary school ('collège'), École A mobilises its community of parents and lecturers to open its students to the world around them, to arouse their curiosity, and to present the different courses of study and professions.

École A also hosts the IPéA ('Institut de préparation au supérieur Acadomia'), an institute offering integrated preparation for 'post-bac' school exams, which helps high school students work on their future project. Students benefit from the network of experienced Acadomia guidance counsellors and coaches.



Our online campus, A.LIVE

The Acadomia group developed a digital solution: A.LIVE. This online learning platform which allows our pupils to learn English online, individually, or collectively to reach absolute educational continuity and to support students at home or during the holidays.
